PURPOSE

The information outlined below will help guide your video submission for Union College.

STEPS

- Choose **ONE** of the options below for submitting your interview video:

Option 1:

Upload your interview video file. A total of 4 mini-videos should be submitted with this option (ONE video for EACH question below. Each mini-video should be no longer than 2 minutes).

Option 2:

Upload your interview video to Google or a private YouTube channel, then submit the Google Link or YouTube Link directly in the application. When sharing your video through a link, you may submit one video (no longer than 5 minutes long) or a total of 4 mini-videos (ONE video for EACH interview question. Each mini-video should be no longer than 2 minutes)

****We strongly suggest using a computer to upload your videos into the application system.** For technical difficulties email unioncollege@theunionchurch.com. 500MB is the maximum file size for the entire submission. If the total size of your submission is bigger than that, create a zip file and then upload. For technical difficulties email unioncollege@theunionchurch.com.****
